Wassamasaw Tribe Powwow Vendor Terms and Conditions

Vendors will receive an email of acceptance. The Wassamasaw Tribe reserves the discretion to grant or refuse any request from individuals or companies wishing to exhibit in the Powwow.

Cancellation Policy

Please note that your space rental fee is non-refundable. This event is rain or shine. Another day may be used as a make-up day if necessary due to severely inclement weather, and the tribe will advise if that change is made prior to the event day.

Subletting/Shared Space

Subletting space is prohibited. The Vendor shall not assign, sublet, or apportion the whole or any part of the space allocated by the Wassamasaw Tribe to the Vendor.

Exhibit Space

Spaces are assigned by the Powwow Director. You cannot change your assigned space. If there is an issue, please speak with the Powwow Director. Vendors will be responsible for the setting up of their own space this includes providing their own tables and chairs, if more than one is needed at your space. The Vendor agrees to confine its activities to their assigned space.

The Wassamasaw Tribe will not be held liable if competitive Vendors are adjacent to or opposite each other, but, if possible, efforts will be made to allocate space on a basis fair to all Vendors. The Wassamasaw Tribe will not be responsible to a Vendor for any loss or damage caused as a result of the booth being opened and unattended during event hours.

Arrangement of Exhibits

Displays must not protrude beyond your assigned area or obstruct the view of the neighboring booths and may not be taller than 8 ft. Vendors may not attach displays nor suspend anything from the trees. No open flames permitted, under any circumstances. All products, displays and promotional literature must be displayed in a professional and safe manner.

NOTE TO ALL CRAFT VENDORS. DO NOT SELL KNIVES TO CHILDREN WITHOUT PARENTS BEING PRESENT

Set-Up

All vendors must be set up one hour prior to event commencement. Your exhibit must be open and staffed during all hours of the event; Saturday October 11, 2024 from 10 AM – 5 PM

Professionalism

All vendors and their staff shall conduct themselves in a courteous, polite, and professional manner.

Alcohol, Drugs and Weapons

Alcohol, cannabis, or any other illegal drugs/product and weapons are strictly prohibited. Vaping and cigarettes are permitted in designated areas only and never on/in arena grounds.

Pets

Pets are not permitted except for (documented) service dogs.

Noise & Lighting

The Vendor use of loudspeakers, microphones, amplifiers, radios, film equipment or any use of glaring or irregular lighting effects such as but not limited to strobe lights or flashing lights are prohibited.

Care

It is the Vendor's responsibility to keep their area clean and orderly throughout the Powwow event and to ensure it is ready for opening. All trash must be properly disposed of. Your area must be clean following the event.

Advertising

The Vendor may use the name of the Powwow to promote only its participation at the event. It cannot be used in any way that is perceived as an endorsement by the Wassamasaw Tribe of the Vendor's company, product and/or service. Vendors grant the Wassamasaw Tribe the right to utilize any artisan booth or product photograph for promotional consideration.

Insurance

All Vendors are responsible for liability insurance and compliance with any and all requirements with the Town of Moncks Corner and the State of South Carolina.

Safety, Fire and Health

The Vendor will adhere to all local fire & safety regulations. The vendor shall be properly insured for the same. If any Vendor leaves their cooking oil/grease, they will not be invited back to the Powwow.

Liability

The Wassamasaw Tribe shall not under any circumstances whatsoever be liable or responsible for: (a) any loss, damage, theft or destruction whatsoever or howsoever caused to any goods, equipment or any other property belonging to the Vendor or for which the Vendor is responsible (b) any damage or injury suffered by the Vendor or his/her servants or agents, or by any other person (c) any loss, damage, injury, or cost whatsoever suffered by the Vendor by reason of any change in the date, time or place of Exhibition or the abandonment thereof.

General

All matters and questions not covered by these Terms and Conditions are subject to the decision of the Wassamasaw Tribe Executive Board. In addition, the Wassamasaw Tribe shall have full discretion in the interpretation and enforcement of all terms and conditions contained herein. The tribe has the authority to make such amendments in regard to rules and regulations governing the conduct of the participation in the Powwow, as it shall consider necessary for the proper presentation of the Powwow.

The vendor agrees to abide by all decisions of the Wassamasaw Tribe and further agrees to cease any activity that the Wassamasaw Tribe deems to be a violation of the terms and conditions. By signing the Wassamasaw Tribe Powwow Application Form, you agree to the above Terms and Conditions.

PLEASE NOTE: Craft Vendors selling items listed as Native Made are required to be in compliance with the The Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-644). It is illegal to offer or display for sale, or sell any art or craft product in a manner that falsely suggests it is Indian produced, an Indian product, or the product of a particular Indian or Indian Tribe unless that product is from a Federal or State Recognized Tribe and you display the Official Artisan card from that said Tribe.

I/We understand and agree to abide by the rules of the Wassamasaw Tribe as well as those of the Powwow Committee, and Tribal Council.

By submitting the Vendor Application Form, I have read and agree to the above Terms and Conditions of this application. I also understand and agree that this application is not binding, until and unless accepted and agreed upon by the Wassamasaw Tribe of Varnertown Indians, and so accepted and signed shall constitute a binding contract.
